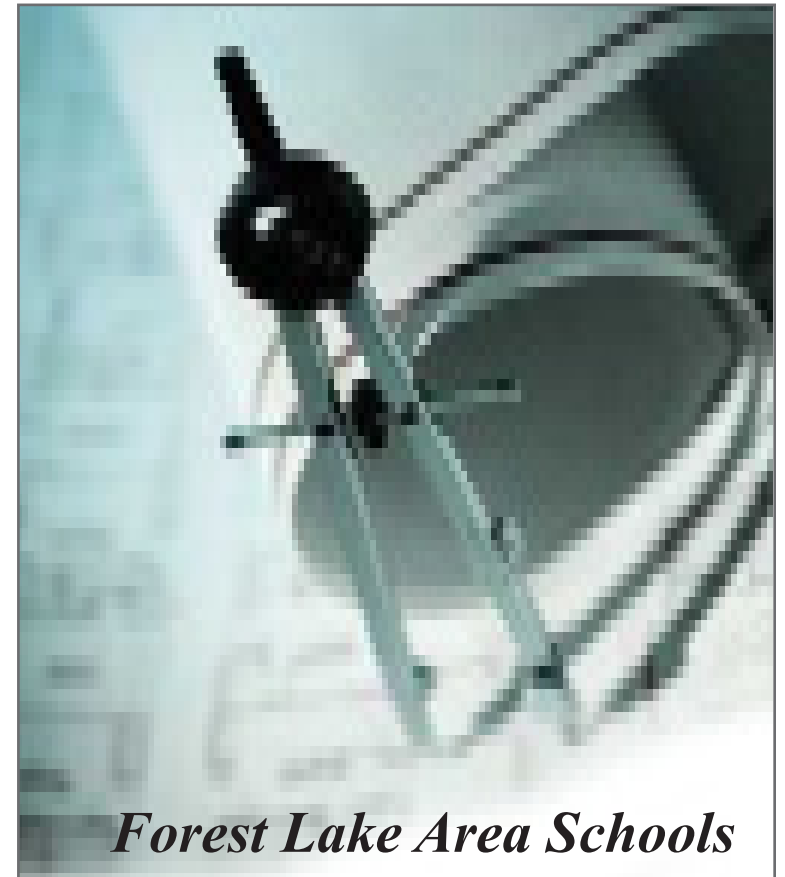

Re-developing a strategic plan for Forest Lake Area Schools

What is Strategic Planning?

The strategic planning process, which was first adopted in January 1999, allows people concerned with the future of our schools to come together to discuss the values and beliefs of our district. This year, parents, community members, teachers, district administrators, business people and others will work together to re-evaluate the district's mission statement and beliefs, and set new goals and objectives for our future.



Why do we need a new strategic plan?

Our communities and our schools are constantly changing. What was good for our students five or 10 years ago may not be the best today. Re-visiting our strategic plan will allow the community to come together to identify the good things we have in place, come up with other ideas that fit our vision, and develop a "big picture" of how we want our district to look in the future.

The strategic planning process

A Strategic Planning Team (made up of community members and district staff) will meet to outline the vision, beliefs and values of the district, and to identify goals and objectives. Action Teams, made up of district staff, will work from that outline to develop strategies that can be implemented in our schools in order to help us reach those goals.

Training session for Action Team Leaders is April 12, 2012 at the District Office. Action Teams meet in April and May to develop strategies to meet district goals.

**June 13,
2012**

Second Planning Session
Strategic Planning Team meets again to review action plans.

**June and July
2012**

School Board reviews and votes on final strategic plan.

**September
2012**

Strategic plan implementation begins.
